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ABSTRACT

This is the sixth module of 10 in the German Headstart program. Each of the 2 units in the module contains objectives, exercises, and a self-evaluation quiz. In addition, there are several supplementary exercises and self-evaluations. The objective of this module is to familiarize the student with expressions connected with various kinds of shopping. There are two situations: (1) buying clothing items, and (2) other types of stores. Both situations contain several conversations for practice in making purchases. (AMH)

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MODULE 6

INTRODUCTION

This module deals with shopping in various German stores. In Unit 1 you will learn how to buy some clothing items, specifying the colors you prefer and indicating how these articles fit you. In Unit 2 you will ask how to get to other types of stores and practice making purchases there.

Although you will find modern supermarkets and department stores in Germany, smaller retail outlets are still abundant, especially in towns and villages. Also, there is considerably less self-service in stores, regardless of their size, and you will have to talk to salespeople if you wish to make purchases.

OBJECTIVES

- At the end of this lesson, you will be able to:
- a. Tell a salesperson that you want to buy certain articles of clothing.
 - b. Understand and ask questions about size and color.
 - c. Tell a salesperson that you want to try something on and indicate how it fits.
 - d. Understand and name eight basic colors.
